



On February 17, 2009, President Obama signed a stimulus bill (The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009) that made some significant changes to the energy efficiency tax credits. Tax credits are now available for home improvements, qualified product:

- Must be "placed in service" from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2010
- Must be for taxpayers principal residence
- Must meet Tax Credit Specification - for entry doors the U factor & SHGC  $\leq$  0.30

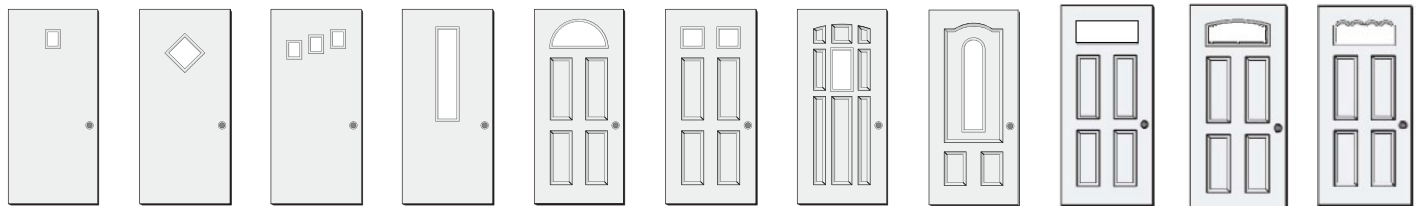

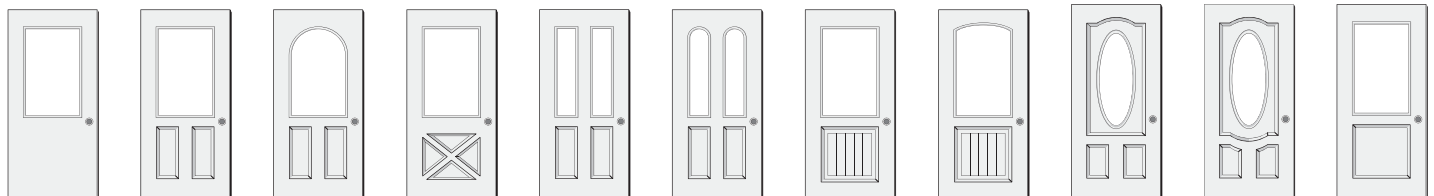

**DOORS WITH 1/2 GLASS AND SMALL OVAL**

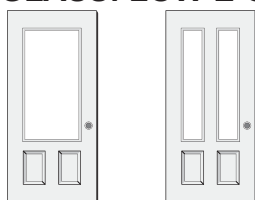
